**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF STEAMBOAT SPRINGS APPROVING THE 2022
HOWELSEN HILL ALPINE SLIDE LICENSE AND AGREEMENT
RECITALS**

WHEREAS, Community Slide, Inc., (“CSI”) is a wholly owned subsidiary of the Steamboat Springs Winter Sports Club, Inc. (“SSWSC”), a Colorado nonprofit corporation; and

WHEREAS, CSI has constructed an approximately 2,400 linear foot two-track alpine slide (the “Slide”) at Howelsen Hill Park, which is owned by the City; and

WHEREAS, the parties on October 16, 2002 entered into a “Howelsen Hill Alpine Slide Lease and Agreement” (hereafter “2002 Agreement”) to set forth certain of their agreements, rights and obligations with respect to the construction and operation of the Slide and related matters, including the City’s agreement to operate the Barrows Lift to provide uphill transportation for Slide customers; and

WHEREAS, Since execution of the 2002 Agreement, the City has encountered serious difficulty in maintaining the Barrows Lift in an operational condition due to the scarcity of replacement parts and soils instability in the vicinity of one or more lift towers and the parties have therefore entered into a 2019 Howelsen Hill Alpine Slide License and Agreement (“2019 Agreement”) to address the operation of the Barrows Lift and the City’s performance under the 2002 Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City, SSWSC, and the Steamboat Springs Winter Sports Club Foundation (“SSWSCF”) have executed a Grant Agreement pursuant to which SSWSC and SSWSCF have agreed to pay to the City \$1,500,000 for the purpose of replacing the Barrows Lift on certain terms and conditions including the execution by the City of the 2022 Howelsen Hill Alpine Slide License and Agreement (“2022 Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has executed the 2022 Agreement and the Council wishes to ratify and approve the 2022 Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF STEAMBOAT SPRINGS, COLORADO, THAT:**

The City Council hereby ratifies and approves the 2022 Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A”.
