**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE SECOND AMENDED INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES BETWEEN THE STEAMBOAT SPRINGS AREA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF STEAMBOAT SPRINGS**

**WHEREAS**, the City and the Steamboat Springs Area Fire Protection District ("District") are parties to the 2009 *Amended Contract For Services Between The Steamboat Springs Rural Fire Protection District And The City Of Steamboat Springs*; and

**WHEREAS**, the boundaries of the District encircle the boundaries of the City and pursuant to the contract, the City provides Emergency Services to persons and properties within the City and the District's service area; and

**WHEREAS**, the City owns certain Emergency Services equipment, facilities, and properties including the Mountain Fire Station and the Yampa Street Station, and the District owns certain Emergency Services equipment, facilities, and properties including the Ambulance Barn, and certain Emergency Services equipment, facilities and properties have been acquired through the Parties' joint funding; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties have been cooperating through the Fire Oversight Committee and desire to update and further clarify the operation, management, maintenance, improvement, and financing of Emergency Services between the Parties; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that updating the agreement between the District and the City will provide for better clarity and coordination between the two entities and facilitate smooth provision of their services to the public.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STEAMBOAT SPRINGS, COLORADO:**

Section 1. That the attached Exhibit A, SECOND AMENDED INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES BETWEEN THE STEAMBOAT SPRINGS AREA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF STEAMBOAT SPRINGS is hereby approved and the Council President or Council President Pro-Tem is directed to execute the Agreement.

Section 2. That pursuant to Section 7-11 of the Charter of the City of Steamboat Springs, Colorado, the second publication of this ordinance may be by reference, utilizing the ordinance title.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

Section 4. The City Council hereby finds, determines and declares that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect five days following publication after final passage as provided in Section 7.6(h) of the Steamboat Springs Home Rule Charter.
