Steamboat Springs

• Regional Transportation Authority (RTA) quickly arose as potential tool

RTA – What Is It?

- An agreement between at least two governmental entities that forms a third governmental entity ("the authority")
- Administers a transportation system with clearly identified boundaries.
- RTA's revenue

- Annual motor vehicle registration fee
- Levy a sales or use tax
- Levy a property tax,
- Issue and/or reissue bonds







- Facilities
- Sidewalks, Shelters, Pedestrian Crossings, other Infrastructure
- Technology
- Fixed Route bus, Commuter bus, Regional bus
- Paratransit, Senior Van, Vanpool, Rideshare,
- Heavy Rail, Light Rail, Subway, Fixed Guideway, Tramway
- Equipment purchase or lease
- Planning, Development, Surveying and Studies
- Trails
- Roads

- Engage a consultant to provide facilitation and technical expertise on the creation of an RTA in the Yampa Valley
- Options of:

Steamboat Springs

- roadway expansion,
- bicycle and pedestrian
- micro-transit & vanpool,
- shared rides
- bus
- bus rapid transit

Cost: \$130-&150K



Next Steps cont.

- City would apply for a Federal 5304 Transit Grant to support the planning and feasibility study this summer
- FTA Section 5304 funds are available for planning projects in rural areas
- 5304 grants require a 20% match: \$26K-\$30K
