

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STEAMBOAT SPRINGS, COLORADO DESIGNATING JAMES J. MOYLAND TO ACT AS HEARINGS OFFICER FOR CAMPAIGN FINANCE AND SHORT-TERM RENTAL LICENSING HEARINGS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Steamboat Springs on July 20, 2021 adopted Ordinance No. 2817 to establish the City of Steamboat Springs Election Code, Chapter 6 of the Revised Municipal Code, Article III of which includes campaign finance regulations and an enforcement process contemplating the appointment of a hearings officer to adjudicate campaign finance complaints;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Steamboat Springs on June 7, 2022 adopted Ordinance No. 2858 to establish licensing regulations for the short-term rentals in the City of Steamboat Springs at Article IX, Chapter 12 of the Revised Municipal Code, which include an enforcement process contemplating the appointment of a hearings officer to adjudicate short-term rental license complaints;

WHEREAS, James J. Moylan currently serves as the City’s hearings officer for matters relating to alcoholic beverage retailer licensing, medical and retail marijuana licensing, and stormwater violations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Steamboat Springs finds it necessary to the public health, safety, and welfare to designate James J. Moylan to act as the City’s hearings officer for matters relating to the City’s Election Code and short-term rental licensing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STEAMBOAT SPRINGS THAT:

James J. Moylan is hereby designated to act as a hearings officer to adjudicate complaints relating to campaign finance matters arising under Article III, Chapter 6 of the City’s Revised Municipal Code and to short-term rental licensing matters arising under Article IX, Chapter 12 of the City of Steamboat Springs Revised Municipal Code.
